

Dear Church Family,

Thank you. There is still more we are seeking to do to restore even unto new heights our time of fellowshipping together!

Another area that has been deeply impacted are team meetings. Throughout these two years the Leadership Team and other particular teams have met as needed. The deacons have continued to consistently meet each quarter in order to make sure that the families of this church body are being ministered to. For this we are all very thankful. We are in agreement that our teams need to come together more often in order to carry out each of their "areas of ministry" within FBC. I have proposed a "kick off" for teams as we start a new church year together.


