During my time of Covid quarantine I began reading a book by David Platt, "Something Needs to Change." You will be hearing more about this book in the future. This will be the next small group study I am going to lead, starting in March. In this book I have been on a hiking journey with David's group through the Himalayas. This book is David's story of what he encountered and the deep soul searching that ensued. This journey has also led to much searching in the depths of my own soul.

Along David's journey he encountered a very rare person living high in the mountains. Her name is Maya. She is a nurse raised down in the valley below in a well-known large Asian city. This nurse could have been in many other places making more money and living in much less harsh conditions. Maya is a Christian. Her goal for each day of life is this, "I just want to do what God wants me to do with what God has given to me." Read through it again - slowly.

I want ... to do
What God wants me ... to do
With what God has given ... to me.

What if that was the goal of each day that God gave you life? What changes would there be in your life if every day you went before your God who has saved your wretched soul and told Him ...

I want to do ...

Whatever You want me to do ...

With what You have given ... to me?

How different would your life look in ...

Your own walk with God — would God be receiving more of your heart, more of your obedience, more of you? Would getting to know God in His word and prayer be something you REALLY looked forward to rather than something you just think you ought to be doing? Would you live every day as if it was a precious gift to you from God? Would you embrace every moment as an opportunity to know Jesus Christ and make Him known? What more would God be doing in and through your life if you sincerely lived each day like this?

Your family – would your family be receiving more of your time, more of your genuine interest, more of you? Would you take more time to take walks with your children, hold them in your arms, play silly games, jump on the trampoline, or play yet another game of chess? Would you tell them more often how much you love them? Would you look for more and more opportunities to make sure they are trusting in Jesus and walking with Jesus in every facet of their lives?

Would I be a better husband? Would I invest even more time to keep a strong marriage strong? Would I look for more ways to let my wife

know how much I cherish her? Would I, with a better attitude, seek to love her sacrificially, whatever that may look like? Would I make sure she knows she is more important than my job, my hobbies, or my weekly household duties? Would I spend even more time on my knees praying for God to make me be the husband He wants me to be to my precious bride?

Your spheres of influence — Would you look for more ways to show the person in front of you, in tangible ways, how much God loves him or her? Would you care even more about whether the person in front of you will spend eternity enjoying the awesome presence and blessings of God RATHER THAN spending eternity in a very real place of suffering - void of the presence of God? Would your family and friends see more of the Living God alive in you through your words and actions?

Your church — Would you be a more vital part of FBC? Would you be more determined than ever to be with God's people when they gather? Would you be more intentionally giving to your God all of your heart, time, talents, and resources so that His purposes could be brought about through His people in Yazoo County and beyond? Would there be more people from Yazoo County walking the aisles on Sunday morning shouting "I'm saved!" because you took the time to tell them what it really means to be in an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ? Would you be looking for more ways to be an encouragement to others in this church body? Would you be more on your knees crying out to God to use FBC to eternally impact Yazoo County and City? Could you be content to go about your life knowing there are still people in this city who do not truly know Jesus? Would you be at the altar more - crying out for God to move, to have His way, in His church, no matter what that may look like?




