David was so deeply impacted in his walk with God that he wrote a Bible Study, "Something Needs to Change: A Call to Make Your Life Count in a World of Urgent Need." Here is a sampling of some thought-provoking questions we will wrestle with on our own and together:

- Do you feel an urgency to share the Gospel with others?
- How are you responding to Jesus right now?
- What urgent physical needs exist in our community?
 What can we do as a group to begin meeting those needs?
- If you're being honest, who are the people and what are the places you would seek to avoid while meeting needs?
- How does the reality of impending judgment increase the urgency to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth?
- What changes in our lives when we meet physical needs for the purpose of meeting a deeper spiritual need?
- What are we missing about Jesus if the way we live never changes?
- What does your life look like when you truly understand what it means to be forgiven?
- Who's a person in your community to whom you could tangibly show the love of God through unselfish love?
- What does prayer look like in your life? When and where do you make time to pray in an intentional, unhurried way?

I know many of us have been crying out to God to take us deeper into our love for God, one another, and those in our lives and this community. This is a discipleship study that I believe has the potential to move us in those directions! I hope to see you on Sunday, March 13th, at 5:00 p.m. I believe this study will be time well invested!

We have a jam-packed summer ahead of us! I pray that you will take the time to be a part!


