mind I myself am a slave to the law of God, but with my flesh, to the law of sin. Therefore, no condemnation now exists for those in Christ Jesus, because the Spirit's law of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death." – Romans 7:21-8:2

"For our battle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the world powers of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavens." — Ephesians 6:12

"Brothers, I do not consider myself to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead, I pursue as my goal the prize promised by God's heavenly call in Christ Jesus." – Philippians 3:13-14

At the ordination service for Dave Eden, we were reminded that the men chosen in Acts 6 were not perfect, but they were maturing in godly character as they daily steeped themselves in God's absolute truth, submitted to the Holy Spirit living within, and in His power obeyed.

As these men served as the Holy Spirit led and enabled them, allowing the Apostles to focus on the specifics God has called them to, "the word of God continued to increase, and the number of the disciples multiplied." – Acts 6:7


